

Sculpture

Sculpture is the art of making three-dimensional forms and figures often out of clay, stone, or wood. Unscramble the terms below related to sculpture by using their definitions as clues.

1. RAIVNCG	CARVING	A sculpting technique that involves wood and stone.
2. ABSEGNMLSI	ASSEMBLING	A sculpting technique in which various materials are gathered and compiled to form one piece.
3. EIOLDMGN	MODELING	A sculpting technique that involves shaping clay.
4. ICTNAGS	CASTING	A sculpting technique that involves making a mold. When the mold hardens, the impression remains in the shape of the mold.
5. SBEA	BASE	A block of material that a sculpture is mounted on.
6. CAELRIP	REPLICA	A reproduction of a piece of art usually on a smaller scale.
7. USTTEA	STATUE	A sculpture that stands by itself and is usually of a person or animal.
8. FDISNEARETGN	FREESTANDING	A sculpture that can be viewed from all sides.
9. NIKEICT	KINETIC	A sculpture that moves from natural forces (wind) or motorized devices.
10. UIMONANTAILP	MANIPULATION	Using one's hands to shape while sculpting.
11. IHSLCE	CHISEL	A sculptural tool used to carve wood and stone.
12. LDMO	MOLD	The hollow or negative form used to create copies of an item.
13. TDAONIDI	ADDITION	A sculpting technique that allows the sculptor to build up or add on to a piece of work.
14. IEOBLM	MOBILE	A moving sculpture that is suspended from the ceiling and moved by air currents.
15. RAURAMTE	ARMATURE	A wire framework used when sculpting with clay or paper.
16. IELERF	RELIEF	A sculpting technique where the sculpted elements stay attached to a wall or solid background made of the same material.
